Learning Outcomes

After completing this activity, learners will be able to:

- Define blue economy and its objectives
- Identify and describe the different characteristics of a blue economy
- Understand the application of blue economy in real world scenarios

Length of Activity

90 - 120 minutes

Materials Required

- What is a Blue Economy Backgrounder

Step 1: Introducing the Concept

Begin by watching the following video on blue economy:

After watching the video, continue on to distributing the topic backgrounder to your learners and have them read the information provided on blue economy.

Step 2: Research and Discussion

After watching the video and reading the backgrounder, encourage students to further explore the concept of a blue economy by discussing and researching the following questions:

- How would you describe a blue economy?
- What is the purpose of a blue economy?
- What are different sectors and industries that are considered in a blue economy?
- How is a blue economy different from a traditional economy?
- Why is it important to explore the need for sustainable economic development for oceans?
- How can a blue economy help address concerns of climate change?
- How is a blue economy relevant for Canada?

Step 3: Essay Assignment
