



# Energy Savings Plan Outline Example

*The following is an example of an Energy Savings Plan for you to use to help guide you in creating your own Energy Savings Plan. You may want to create a brainstorming map to get started on your Energy Savings Plan!*

<b>Who is involved?</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• identify who will be involved (<i>i.e. Eco club, class, teachers, etc.</i>)</li></ul>
<b>Investigation</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• walking through you school or learning environment, investigate different sources, devices that use electricity (<i>i.e. computers</i>)</li></ul>
<b>Gathering Data</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• gather data on your school's or learning environment's electricity usage (<i>i.e. review electricity bills, track # of energy devices, electronics, appliances, etc.</i>)</li></ul>
<b>Goal Setting</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• set achievable goals (<i>i.e. turning off lights, powering off and unplugging computers, etc.</i>)</li></ul>
<b>Take Action</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• identify actions to take to bring awareness to your school's or learning environment's energy consumption/usage (<i>i.e. Energy Out Event, posters, etc.</i>)</li></ul>
<b>Solutions</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• identify possible solutions to reduce your school's or learning environment's energy consumption/usage (<i>i.e. upgrade lightbulbs to LEDs</i>)</li></ul>
<b>Educate</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• educate your classmates, and members of your school or learning environment (<i>i.e. assemblies, announcements, newsletters, etc.</i>)</li></ul>
<b>Track &amp; Share</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• track and share your school's or learning environment's progress in reducing energy usage</li></ul>
<b>Make it Ongoing</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• continue reducing your energy footprint by following your established Energy Savings Plan!</li></ul>
